Meeting Minutes

SPC 84-1991R - Method of Test for Rating Air-to-Air Energy Recovery Ventilators

Pacific J, San Francisco Marriot Hotel
2:15 PM, Monday, January 19, 1998

Meeting called to order at 2:15 pm, Monday, January 19, 1998 by Chairman Kirk Mescher. (A list of attendees with phone, fax, and e-mail is available at the members-only area of the TC 5.5 site.) Motioned by Dale Rammien, seconded by Gerry Martin, that the minutes from the previous meeting be adopted as circulated. Carried (8,0,1).

Chairman Mescher reviewed the status and progress on the current round of revisions to Standard 84. He noted that the committee has determined that this version of the Standard must include error analysis. The 1997 ARI Standard 1060 "Rating Air-to-Air Energy Recovery Ventilation Equipment" references Standard 84 as the method of test. This means there is some urgency for this committee to complete its revisions. He hopes to have a revised working draft of Standard 84 for the June 1998 meeting of ASHRAE in Toronto and a public review draft in place by January 1999. Committee members and working groups are to review the specific sections of the Standard to which they have been assigned and forward their comments, edits and changes to Mescher in the near future. He will incorporate the comments, edits and changes into the draft Standard for review by committee members prior to the Toronto meeting.

The meeting was dissolved into working groups, wherein group members discussed revisions to their respective sections of the Standard.
